Important notes to Parents & Teachers (5)

In recent years there have been many studies to show that Repetitive Strain Injury (RSI), Posture Injury and Eye Problems are on the increase. It is therefore vital that we introduce good practises right from day one. Please make sure that you follow instructions. POP-UPS will appear at the beginning of each game as a reminder to both you and your pupils.

Repetitive Strain Injury is caused by tapping at the keys in a dis-organised fashion and as speeds become faster the movement becomes jarred putting extra strain on the wrists and lower arms. By learning to touch type the fingers move more smoothly taking away the straining movement.

Posture Injury. As it becomes more common place to sit at a computer from our early years it is important to have good posture to avoid neck and back strain. Please ensure that you follow the instructions at the beginning of this program.

Eye Strain It is recommended that regular breaks are taken away from the screen to avoid eye strain if using the computer for long periods. Limit the total usage time used in front of the screen for small children. Check that there is no glare from the screen from both artificial as well as natural sunlight. Yearly eye checks from an optician are recommended.











General Options - Typing 27







Some schools have found it useful to set up their computers so that the 2Simple Program Launchers are displayed automatically when the computer starts up. Though this is possible on a standard Windows PC, there may be complications with some security systems.

If you wish to make links to the individual programs, you can do so in the usual way. Most school computers have some security or 'front-end' for users which can make this more complicated. You may need to refer to the manuals which come with the PC to seek further information on this
